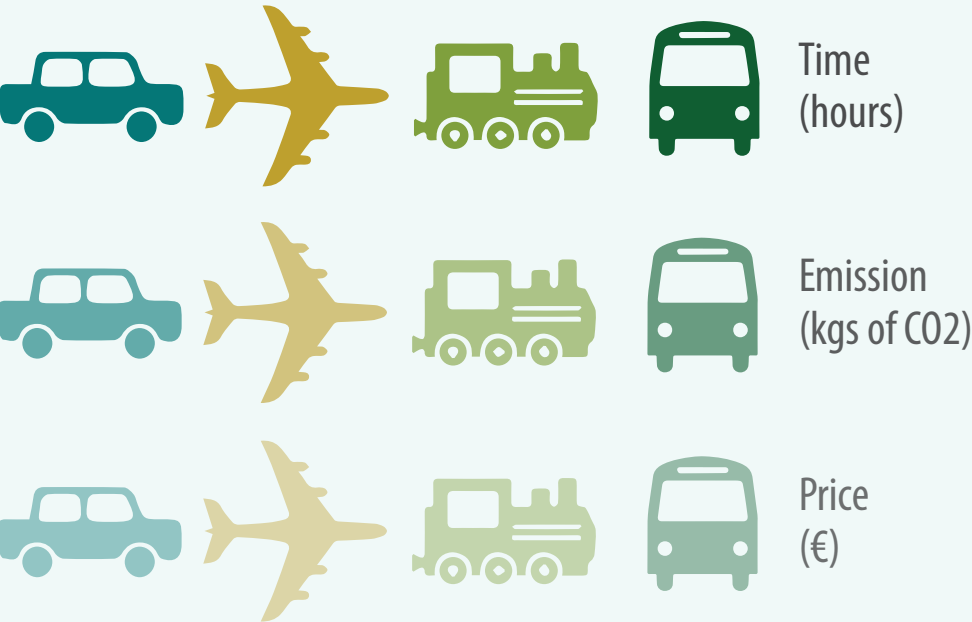


The map shows flight distances between the biggest city of each region. All train tickets that cost 239 euros are interrail tickets. Youth travellers aged 12-25 who travel 2nd class get 35% discount. Find out more at <http://www.interrail.eu/interrail-passes/global-pass> Ticket prices and availability have been checked for 15th September 2014 on 25th August 2014. For most European cities the nearest airport is located within 15km of the border of the city. Budget flights mainly use airports within a much greater distance, often more than an hour bus or train drive.
